Newsletter Info

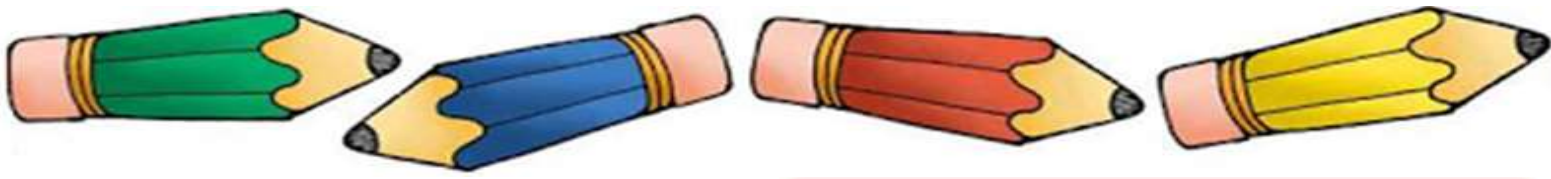
