3rd Grade Reading

The 3rd grade Reading class was introduced to classroom procedures last week. This week we will be working on some get to know you activities. We will also begin testing this week to determine Lexile levels if the SRC program is up and running. Students will then begin finding books at their level for independent reading. In the P.A.C.E. classroom, students use the SRC (Scholastic Reading Counts) program to work on reading comprehension and quiz over the books they have read at home and in the classroom. Students earn points for each book they read with the SRC program. I will be working with students each Trimester to set a point goal that they will work towards. More information will be sent home once students have completed Lexile testing.



Homework

Homework consists of reading for 20 minutes each night. Occasionally, students might have other homework such as a project to work on, but this will be communicated well in advance.
