Friday- No School

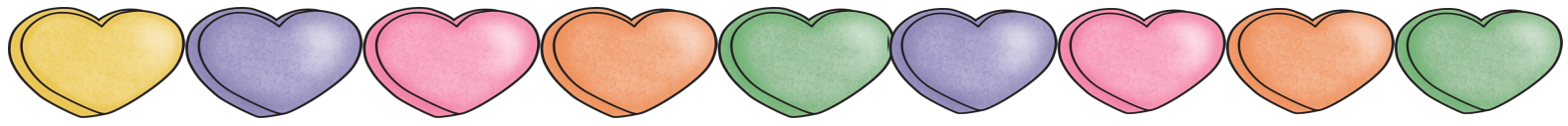

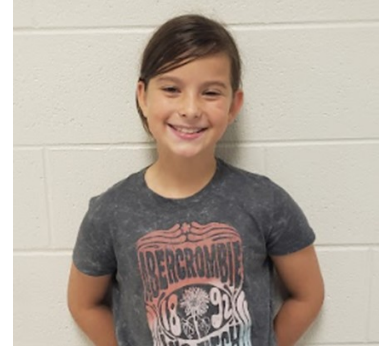
