Star Students are "Students Taking Awesome Responsibility." Students are chosen for this honor based on classroom behavior, attitude, and responsibility.



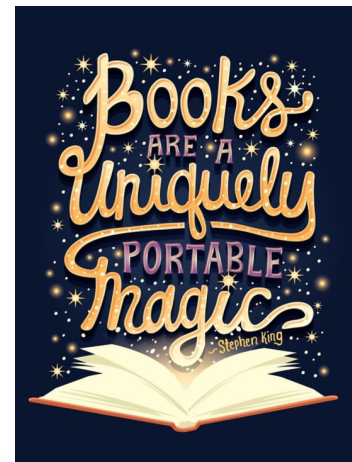
TEACHER'S CORNER
